

Move About expands in Trollhättan

In collaboration with Eidar, Move About is opening their fourth car sharing location in Trollhättan – located at Bergslagstorget by the central station. The three shared cars are now available to book for citizens, residents, and employees in the nearby area.

For several years, Move About has collaborated with Högskolan Väst, Innovatum and Kraftstaden on electric car sharing in Trollhättan. Currently, there are three locations open for bookings with the purpose of increasing sustainable transportation within the Innovatum-area.

Together with the public housing company Eidar, Move About now strengthens their presence in the city by further expanding in Trollhättan.

A great spot for shared cars

The brand-new car sharing station consists of two Nissan Leaf (40 kWh) and one Nissan Leaf (62 kWh) and is located at Bergslagstorget nearby the central station in Trollhättan. Because of the high amount of people passing through every day, this is an attractive location for shared electric cars. The varying range of the cars makes it easy for users to find a good alternative for their trip.

"Location is of course a very important aspect in car sharing. To be able to offer shared electric cars at such a central and strategic location in Trollhättan makes our offer attractive to both citizens, commuters, and other travelers", Peter Aldby, Country Manager at Move About, says.
